CHICAGO— Nearly three and a half years after the appellate court vacated his conviction, Renard Jackson was awarded \$5.75 million by a Cook County jury for spending over four years in prison for a crime he didn't commit. At trial, Mr. Jackson offered substantial evidence that Chicago Police Officers lied and fabricated evidence to secure his conviction. The jury deliberated for less than an hour and returned a verdict for Mr. Jackson on all claims, and awarded him the exact amount requested by his attorneys.
